POTATO PRICE IS HIGH HERE
Arrival of Fresh Seasonal Fruits and Vegetables Features Local Retail Price
The price of old potatoes on the local market has taken a decided advance recently but there will be relief for the situation when the new crops begin to move in more freely. The first of the new crop potatoes are already here—California spuds retailing at 10c per pound and British Columbia at two pounds for 35c.
There has been a slight decrease in the price of sugar but a stiffening is expected with the canning season starting soon. Thrifty housewives would be well advised to lay in their sugar stocks at this time.
Asparagus from Terrace and other interior points has proven very popular on the local market this spring. The supply is about over.
Fine juicy Valencia oranges are now in to take the place of navals. Orange prices are advancing. There are also sharp advances in lemon prices.
With stocks of last year's crop nearing exhaustion, apple prices are jumping. The new crop should soon be starting to come in.
Florida grapefruit is now practically finished but there is plenty of California grapefruit, quality of which has greatly improved in recent years.
Strawberries feature the fresh fruit market just now. While the supply to date has been mostly from Kennewick, Wash., and Hood River, Ore., Southern B. C. berries of fine quality are now commencing to move in.
Limited supplies of Bing cherries from California are being offered at 60c a pound. Fresh cantaloupes are selling at 25c to 30c according to size. Water-melons and plums will be along soon.
Wheat prices are stiffening up. There has been a general advance in the meat market here recently.
