### Income Tax Is On Increase

OTTAWA, Nov. 7.—An increase of more than ten million dollars in income tax collections is noted in the return just issued by the minister of national revenue, Hon. W. D. Euler, the figures embracing a period beginning the fiscal year April 1 to the present date and comparing with the corresponding period last year.

The total amount collected in seven months was \$63,760,000. This year's collections in British Columbia amount to \$4,124,000, an increase of more than \$293,000.
