Ten Years Ago in Prince Rupert

August 9, 1919 Prince Rupert district did a big share in winning the war. Practically all the boys that amounted to anything and who were fit, went overseas. Over 500 served in the military or naval forces and many gave their lives for the cause.

One of the prettiest weddings of the season took place last evening at the Catholic Church rectory, when Miss Mae Ryan, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. J. J. Ryan of this city, became the bride of Thomas J. Maloney, of Seattle, formerly of the G.T.P. service here.

Work has commenced on the new car ferry slips which are being built by the Grand Trunk Pacific for the hauling of the products of the district in car load lots without transshipment.

Capt. E. C. Hoy in a race against darkness successfully completed his long flight from Vancouver to Calgary arriving there and landing safely at 8:55 last evening.

W. A. Matheson, a returned soldier, was appointed to the position of building inspector and collector by the city council last night.

A big gold strike has been made by Robert McGinnis at the head of the glacier on the Kitsault near the granite contact. Considerable excitement prevails among the prospectors of the district who are rushing in.

Lieut.-Com. Russel P. Ponder has returned after seeing a good deal of service overseas with the British Navy. He was formerly provincial police constable at Hazelton, but immediately on the opening of the war he rejoined the naval service. He has now been appointed provincial police constable at Massett.
