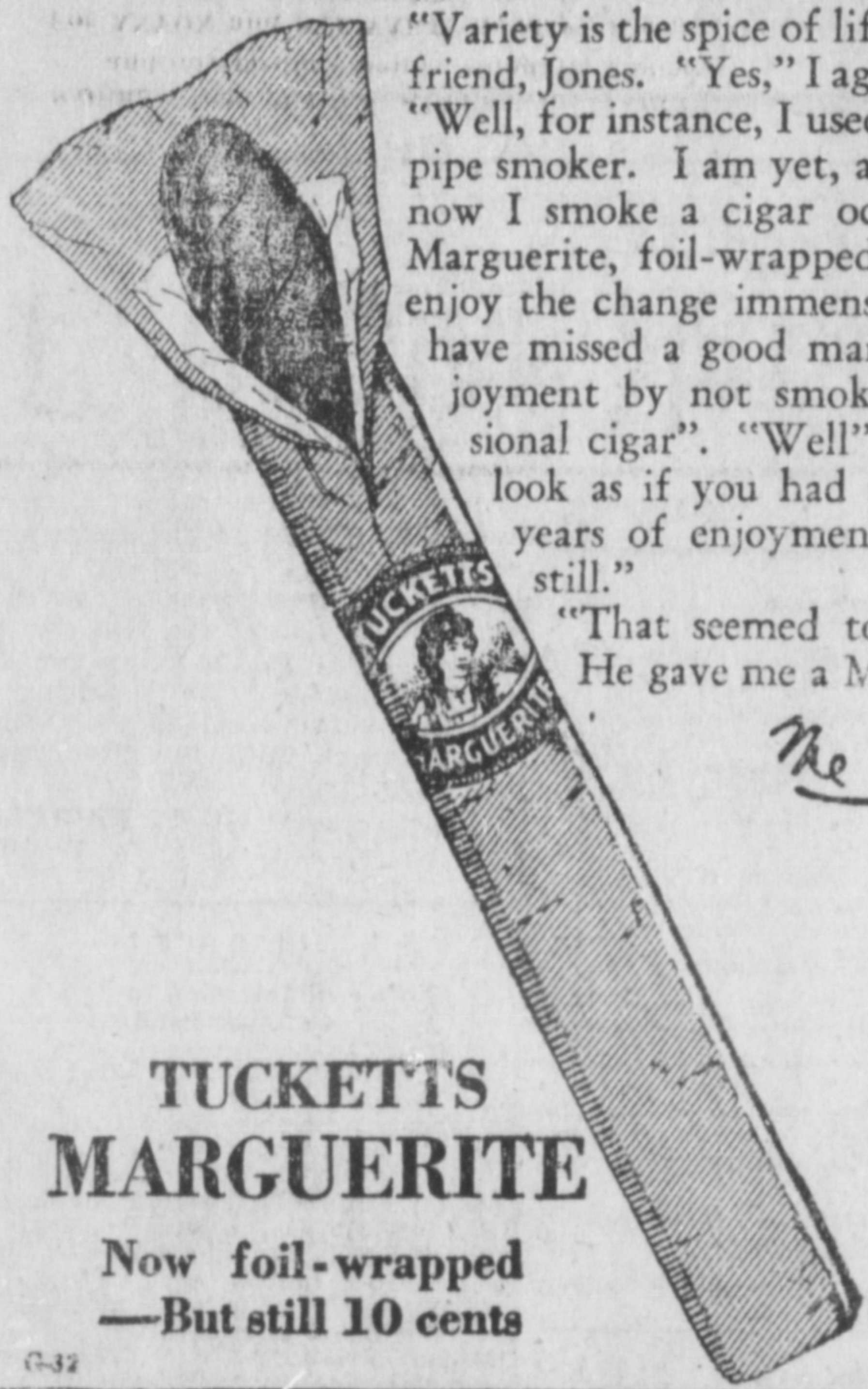


# Jones Makes a Discovery

# LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR ARRIVES FROM NORTH

Next Thursday, after having made the trip to Massett Inlet, the lieutenant governor will be again in the city aboard the steamer Prince Charles bound for Victoria.

Amos Godfrey Victim of Accident at Princess May Mine on McAdams Creek

Amos Godfrey, well known British Columbia miner and resident of the province for forty-five years, was killed recently in an accident at his mine, the Princess May, at McAdams Creek, in the Cassiar district, about 200 miles northwest of Telegraph Creek. Deceased was born 69 years ago in Bedfordshire, England, and came to Nanaimo forty-five years ago, having resided in Vancouver for the past sixteen years. He is survived by a son and three daughters in Vancouver.
