SHOW FOLKS AT THE WESTHOLME

Picture That Tells Something of the Lives of Actors and Actresses

Every girl likes to know about the people of the stage, how they live, how they prepare for their work and how they succeed or fail.

"Show Folks" is one of the best pictures delineating the lives of player folk in vaudeville, ever presented, according to one who has seen the film which is at the Westholme tonight and tomorrow.

The featured players including Eddie Quillan, comedian, Lina Basquette, famous dancer, Bessie Barriscale, former screen favorite, Robert Armstrong, of "Is Zat So?" fame, and Carol Lombard, a clever actress, acquired themselves with the finest artistry in exacting roles.

The theme is decidedly theatrical and many of the scenes transpire behind the curtain of a vaudeville program in which talented players do their various turns, is finely presented.
