United Church to Carry Gospel to Hudson Bay Trading Posts

TORONTO, Ont., Sept. 10- (By Canadian Press) - Departures of two missionaries for Indian work at fur trading posts in northern Manitoba are announced by Rev. Arthur Barner, superintendent of Indian missions in Canada for the United Church, lately returned from his annual summer inspection of stations in the western provinces.

Rev. Roscoe T. Chapin, for some years stationed at Island Lake. Man, who has been visiting his family in Essex county, has returned to his appointment, having left the east for Winnipeg to begin the first stage of his 500-mile journey into the wilds.

Nelson Gaudin, son of Rev. S. D. Gaudin, missionary at Norway House, Man., has accepted assignment as missionary-teacher at Nelson House. He has a complete mastery of the Cree language, gained as a child among the Indians at various mission houses.

Beginning as teacher at Oxford House two years ago, Mr. Gaudin found that, after 10 years' absence in Winnipeg for education in English, the Cree was still almost his day and Saturday, \$2 return. mother tongue.
