# Flying Post Offices Being Built by U. S.

PARIS, Dec. 11.—Paris, the goal vertible transport aeroplanes are being built for the time when the air mail will be sorted in transit They are tri-motored, 18- passenger ships that may be made into flying post office within 24 hours. Carriers of the transcontinental mail estimate that three hours would be cut from the present time if mail clerks were aboard. aeroplanes to sort the thousands of letters carried daily.
