Ten Years Ago in Prince Rupert

May 7, 1919

During the month of April a total of 2,542,000 pounds of halibut was marketed at Prince Rupert, bringing total landings for the year from January 1 to 5, 1919, 6,546,000 pounds. Prices in April ranged from 10c and 7c up to 15c and 14c.

Bacon is selling at 55c a pound in Prince Rupert while ham is bringing 50c.
