At the regular weekly meeting last night of the Salvation Army Young People's Legion, Miss Edith Leek was elected secretary in place of Mrs. William Kerr.

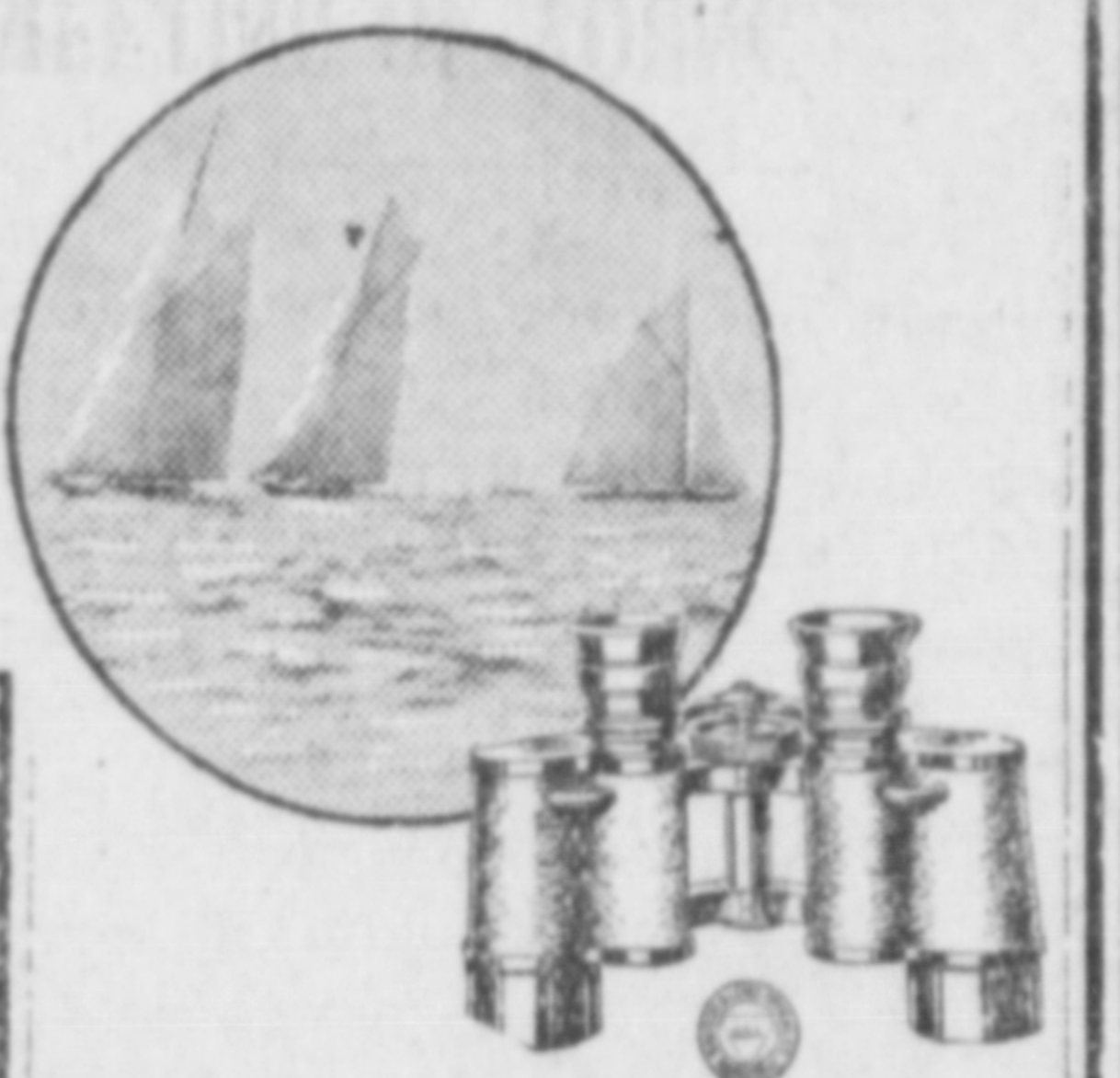
It was decided to hold a boating party or hike on May 24 and to invite members of Rupert East United Church Young People's Society to be guests of the legion at the last meeting this month.
