The Prince Rupert Dry Dock & Engineering Co. is about to build a three storey boarding house to accommodate one hundred men who will be employed in ship construction at the local dry dock.

Thirty two men were arrested and charged with gambling as a result of a raid last night on the premises of the Skeena Club. The raid was carried out by Constables Adams, Bailey, McGilchey and Duff.

Ten cents and upwards was paid for halibut here today. Boats included the Polaris, Mayflower, Thelma, Caygeon, Tide, Viola, Nautilus.

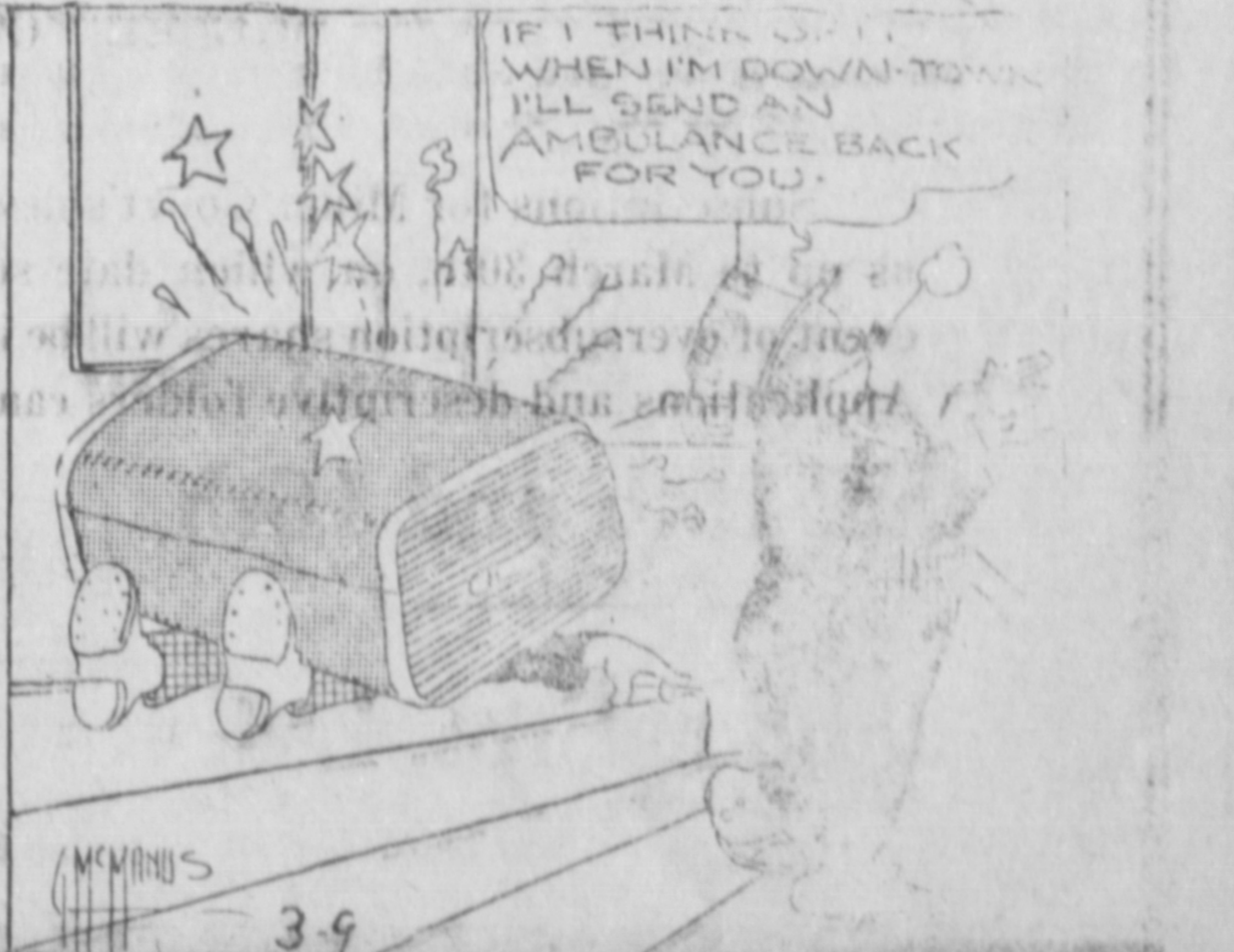
