LAND REGISTRY ACT

(Sections 36 and 134.)

Re Application No. 11,044-L. File 6,198. ... E that application has been made to register Jim Postulu of Prince Rupert, B. C., as owner in fee under a Tax Sale Deed from the Collector of the City of Prince Rupert, bearing date the 19th day of December, 1918, of ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, lying and being in the City of Prince Rupert, more particularly known and described as Lot Seven (7), Block twenty-five (25), Section Seven (7), Map 923; You are required to contest the claim of the tax purchaser within 35 days from the date of the service of this notice (which may be effected by publication in a daily newspaper), and your attention is called to section 36 of the "Land Registry Act" with amendments, and to the following extract therefrom:—

"and in default of a caveat or certificate of indefeasible title being filed before the registration as owner of the person entitled under such tax sale, all persons so served with notice, and those claiming through or under them, and all persons claiming any interest in the land by virtue of any unregistered instrument, and all persons claiming any interest in the land by virtue of a deed or other instrument, shall be deemed to have accepted the sale as owner of the land so sold for taxes."
