and not one watereshed alone, but the watersheds of all the earth are contributing to the ocean of wheat which will sweep away this manmade barrier. Let them keen that barrier intact a day too long, and Canada will be strewn with wreckage by the devastating torrent that the Wheat Pool is creating.


