The Grand Trunk Pacific Railway Co. will not build its terminal buildings here, including station and freight offices, until it is exactly known what the requirements of the Prince Rupert Dry Dock & Engineering Co. will be, states H. H. McCall, general superintendent of the railway.

Angus Macdonald, principal of the public school, informed the school board last night that the total attendance at the public schools in the city now stood at 540. (The total attendance at the public schools now is in the neighborhood of 1,000.

A committee consisting of Judge F. McB. Young, George Hill, W. E. Thompson, S. D. Macdonald and Major J. H. McMullin has been appointed to proceed with plans for the erection of a memorial to commemorate those who lost their lives in the Great War.
