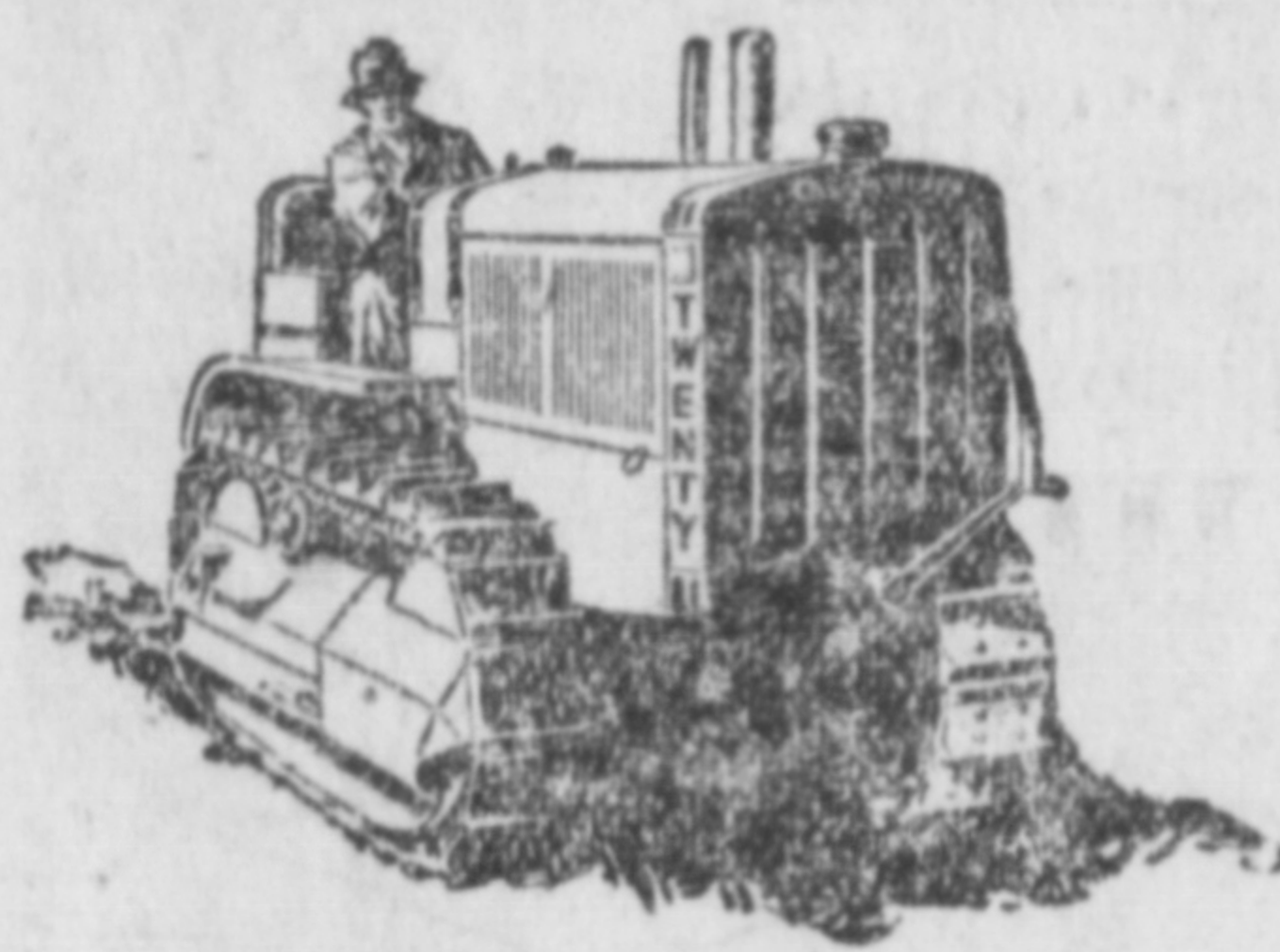

OUTDOOR ANNEX TO HOSPITAL PLANNED

House Committee to Draw Up Plans and Get Estimates—Laundry Arbitration Board Not Favored

The house committee was empowered at last night's meeting of the hospital board to proceed with the drawing up of plans for a proposed outside shelter for the housing of pneumonia and tuberculosis patients. It is suggested that there be two sections to the proposed annex, one for pneumonia cases and another for tuberculosis and that part at least of it be heated. The views of the doctors will be obtained and prices received for a later report to the board.

The house committee, through Ald. Brown, reported that the proposed arbitration board in connection with laundry work would be too expensive and cumbersome. It was felt that a careful check-up of laundry as it came back to the hospital would meet the situation just as well. A recommendation that tenders be called for a new coal range for the hospital kitchen was also adopted. An electric stove had been considered but it was felt that there was also need of heating the kitchen during cold weather.

COLD STORAGE SCOW IS SOLD

B. C. Packers' Plant Disposed of By Underwriters to Vancouver Packing Concern

The B. C. Packers' cold storage scow, which broke adrift from a towboat in Hesate Straits some time ago and was seriously damaged when she stranded before being finally salvaged, has been sold by the underwriters to C. Chalberg, representing the Nissen Packing Co. of Vancouver. The scow is undergoing repairs at the Prince Rupert drydock before being taken after June 1 to Vancouver, where she will be fitted with new machinery and used as a cold storage plant.

HOSPITALS MUST BUY ALCOHOL IN FUTURE FROM LIQUOR VENDOR

A letter was read at last night's meeting of the hospital board from the Consolidated Distillery Co., announcing that it had been ruled that sales of alcohol to hospitals were in contravention of the Government Liquor Act and that, in future, hospitals would have to purchase their alcohol direct from the Government Liquor Store at advanced prices. It was suggested that a joint protest at this ruling be made by all hospitals of the province with a view to having this clause in the act rescinded.

H. W. Birch, managing secretary, stated that the change would just about double the cost of alcohol for the hospital. At the suggestion of Alex McRae and Ald. W. M. Brown, it was decided to take the matter up with the B. C. Hospitals Association and also make a protest to the Liquor Control Board.
