# First Aid

Often householders may have wondered how to remove paint effectively which has dried and hardened on house hardware such as chrome and brass doorknobs, lighting and plumbing

It should be remembered that paint will remove easily a day or so after painting has been done by wiping with turpentine. To remove hardened paint from metal and tile surface, a solution of washing soda or trisolium phosphate in a cup of warm water will do the trick.

A little fine steel wool will help to accelerate the paint removing job, but do not rub very hard.

Do not use this solution on wooden floors. Dried paint there is best removed with steel wool only. A covering of wax will hice any blemisnes.

It may be desired also by some homeowners to keep a deteriorating asphalt roof a year or two longer. If so, a roof of this kind can be coated with an asphalt roof coating, generally sold by roofing supply dealers or hardware stores.





With winter's breath slowly but surely wafting down from the north, the homeowner well advised now to begin thinking about uncovered pipes,


As many found out last winter, frozen water pipes can cause all manner of discomforts and annoyances, not to mention expenses. But with a little advance planning, much or all of this can be spared.







