C. N. R. TROUBLE DELAYED TRAIN

Freight Derailed on the National
Transcontinental and Inter-
ferred With Express
Arriving Here.

The cause of the delay of last evening's train from the east was the wreck of a Canadian Northern freight train near Junkus station. About three miles this side of the station the train was derailed and two cars were smashed by falling over the embankment.

The trouble held up the Grand Trunk transcontinental as the two railways run on the same line in that region. A local train was dispatched from Prince George which arrived on time last evening but the main train from the east did not reach here until six o'clock this morning.

The Prince Rupert was late in arriving from Anxox last evening and was held over until seven o'clock this morning.
