CINCINNATI (CP) — Warren C. Giles will become president of the National League October 16 and will establish headquarters in Cincinnati.

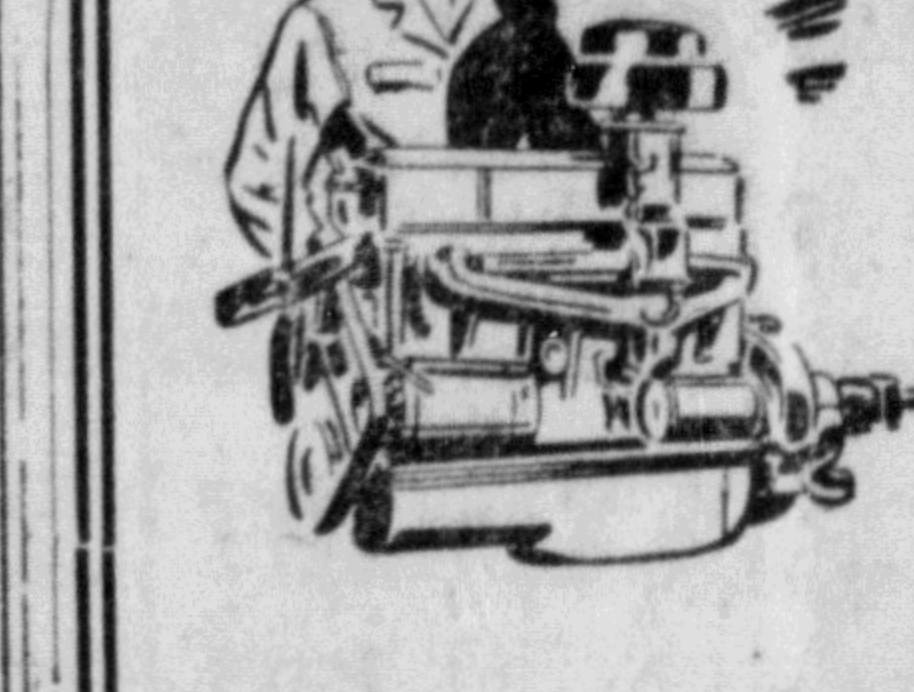
That was determined today when Giles, president and general manager of the Cincinnati Reds, accepted an invitation to take the post.

Giles succeeds Ford Frick who has become commissioner of organized baseball.



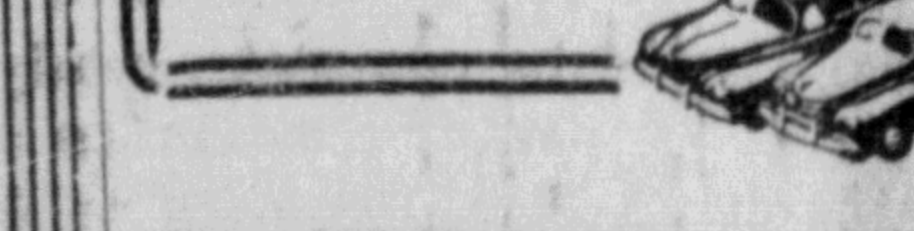

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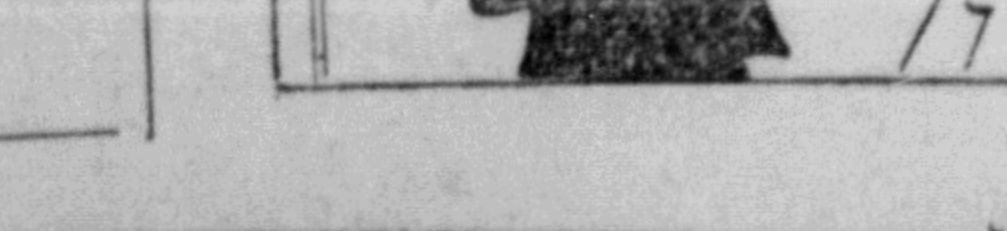
