Gardening....

KEEP COLD FRAME BUSY, AS FALL AND WINTER SHELTER

View of Cold Frame in Winter
A cold frame can be used in the fall quite as profitably as in the spring. If your garden lacks one, this is a good time to build it and keep it busy during the winter months. Flowers for the house this winter as well as for next spring's garden can be given an early start in a cold frame. It serves well for rooting winter flowering bulbs. Hyacinths, early tulips, narcissi and daffodils are the principal ones which need a dark, cool situation. Bury them in the frame bed in the pots you expect to grow them in, and when roots have developed sufficiently bring them indoors for the quick growth of the tops and blossoms. The frost of late fall brings to mind problems of harboring perennial seedlings. If you planted them late they will no doubt need some additional protection, and the cold frame will provide it. The best all-around method is to pot the plants and set them into the frame. Such treatment assures them a few more weeks of growth, and will enable them to benefit from extra warmth in the spring and get an early start. They will also be easily transplanted. Two lovely perennials which are difficult to grow without protection are the foxgloves with their stately spires, and the canterbury bells. Although they are perfectly hardy as far as cold weather is concerned, they are very susceptible to wet weather, and thawing and freezing. There is only one safe way to grow them in cold climates and that is by wintering them in a cold frame, where they will be safe from wet and the changes in temperature will be tempered by

and they have learned through their experience playing to such audiences, how to choose a program that will appeal to the average person. I would like to see more support given to these concerts. My suggestion is that a central committee be formed with a representative from many organizations such as, the schools, the students' council, Atlin Fish, B.C. Packers, the Cellanese, HMCS Chatham, the Co-op, the Reserve Army and so on. Each representative would be responsible for urging the sale of season tickets (with the 40 percent reduction that Civic Centre members get) within the particular organization this person represents. I think we could then put over the concerts in a big way, developing the needed concert consciousness. We might soon rival Alaska where they charge double our prices, pack their houses with enthusiastic audiences, and buy pianos and furnish halls with their profits.
