### ESTABLISHED BY MAYOR

It was a model of the tea clipper that inspired the formation of the mariners' club. C. F. Gray of Victoria, a former seaman and mayor of Winnipeg, saw a model of the Cutty Sark in a Winnipeg store and formed the club of retired sailing men.

The real Cutty Sark has been in a dry dock on the Thames River in England for the last 40 years. Built in 1870, she set many speed records on runs from China and Australia but after the inauguration of steamships could get no cargoes.

After a mixed career, including mut.nies and ever-present iriction among her crew, the clipper was sold to a Portuguese firm in 1895 and rechristened Ferreira. She roamed the seas for 10 more years and then was turned into a naval training

The landlocked members of the Cutty Sark Club no longer have an opportunity to see a full-scale version of their namesake because they are thousands of miles from coastal waters.


