Joe Page Relegated

NEW YORK (CP)—Joe Page, former fabulous relief pitcher for the New York Yankees, was the surprised leader of a group of players receiving the axe Wednesday as the major leagues rushed to get within the 25-player limit before the midnight deadline.

Others who were released, retired, optioned or sold outright to the minor leagues included Max Peterson of the New York Yankees; Earl Mossor, Brooklyn; Charlie Bowers, Jack Brittain and Ed Sanicki, Phillies; Steve Bilko, Cardinals; Hal Daugherty, Detroit; Tom Saffell and Monty Bassett, Pittsburgh; and Dick Littlefield, White Sox.

Page, 33-year-old lefthander, was released outright to Kansas City, American Association farm club of the Yankees.

Relief hero of the championship Yankee teams of 1947 and 1949, Page has been on the down grade for more than a year.

SPORT SHOTS

Jess Willard, world heavyweight champion from 1915 to 1918, came out of retirement 26 years ago to sign for a fight against Luis Angel Firpo. Willard had lost his title to Jack Dempsey four years earlier. When Firpo knocked him out, that was the end of the ring for the giant Willard.

Man O'War, rated by many as the best racehorse ever foaled in the United States, was at the peak of his career as a three-year-old when he won the Preakness stakes 31 years ago today. Man O'War set five records at distances from a mile up to that campaign. The great horse died in 1947 at age 30, after earning \$1,000,000 in stakes, stud fees and sale of foals.

A crowd of 15,000 turned out for the first Sunday baseball game at Washington, D.C., 33 years ago and saw a 12-inning duel in which the Senators finally snatched a 1-0 victory over the Cleveland Indians. The game was notable in that each team committed six errors in the tense struggle.
