Italian Port Is U.S. Base

Leghorn Is Resuming Second World War Role

LEGHORN, Italy (AP)—Bomb-blasted Leghorn is resuming its Second World War role of a major United States supply base.

Through the still-scarred port, liberated by American soldiers in 1945, flow the supplies of the U.S. occupation army in Austria.

With in a few months, 100 officers, 650 soldiers and 2,000 Italian civilian employees will be operating this end of the supply lifeline running a rail through the famed Brenner Pass in the Alps.

It's a ticklish job. Leghorn's city government is communist. The port union and the stevedore's association are bossed by the Reds. So far, however, there have been no incidents involving Italians and U.S. personnel.

In charge of the new base, granted to the United States by Italy over furious Communist protests, is Col. Norman H. Vissering of Lake Wales, Fla.

Vissering has leased a 25-acre dock area north of Leghorn in the same location as the huge wartime dumps of Gen. Mark Clark's Fifth Army. A bombed-out 15-acre steel works was taken over for warehouse space.

A temporary headquarters has been set up in a former gambling casino at Tirrenia, six miles north of Leghorn.

Five floors of a half-completed new office building will be the permanent headquarters.

The troops are living in a former resort hotel where they eat off white table cloths and have a spic-and-span new post exchange. An American school for dependents opened Sept. 10.

Little post-war reconstruction has been done in Leghorn. Italian capital avoided the city because the communists pulled strike after political strike in the factories.

As a result there is a housing shortage. When news broke of the new U.S. base, a major Red propaganda claim was that the Americans would make the housing situation more acute.

PRIVATE DEVELOPMENT

Colonel Vissering trumped that propaganda, ace. He persuaded private Italian capital to build a housing development especially for the Americans. Married soldiers will pay about \$80 a month for a home. That's far below the average rent here.

The major task of the new base is to provide a safe, short supply route to Austria.

The former route ran from the German port of Bremen across Germany to Austria. That could be quickly cut if the Russians attacked across Germany.

Informed sources say if the Russians struck at Austria, Allied armies would fall back on the easily defended Alps around the Brenner Pass. Leghorn could keep ammunition and guns rapidly moving up to forces fighting there.

One indirect result of the U.S. base may be that Leghorn will

abandon communism. The city has 14,000 unemployed, according to best estimates. The Americans will lower this by 2,000 and also stimulate indirect employment.

American soldiers in the command are in a peculiar position. Modern Italy never before has permitted foreign garrisons within her borders in peacetime. One tricky political problem still has to be solved. The Americans are unwilling to hire dock laborers from the communist-controlled Stevedores Association. They have been hiring non-union non-communists.

Five hundred of the 1,300 stevedores in the association are non-communist. They are bitter that they have been by-passed for jobs.

Leghorn's non-communists fear bitter labor strife may begin between the association stevedores and the non-union men working the docks for the Americans. They are hopeful a compromise will be arranged in which the U.S. authorities will hire non-communist members of the stevedore's association under a special arrangement guaranteeing they would not abide by any political strike call.
