"Dozens of Canadian clothing firms are clinging to the solvent side of the ledger by narrowing threads. Unless something happens, and quickly, there could be a few shutters going up along Canada's textile row."
The greatest of all mysteries is how prices can stay up in Canada when stocks of unsold goods have reached an all-time high. The Bureau of Statistics reports, November 3, that inventories in August reflected a \$56,000,000 increase from July and a total advance of \$899,000,000 from August last year.
Old-fashioned economists would say that one of these days the dam was due to burst, and prices would fall, with a big bang.

A list of early newcomers to Skeena, printed in The News, Thursday, aroused wide interest here as well as along the river. It represented a registration of pioneers who came to the district, up to 1912—who they were and how. Some dates went back to 1901. They came on foot. They voyaged by boat and canoe and steamer. They followed the long and lonely trails, for there was no railway and there was many a region not fully explored. Could a newspaper of today know what they could have told about, what an incomparable gist of true stories it could print!




