





Storage space is available in the coat and linen closets in the hall, the coat closet in the rear entry, two closets in each bedroom, the china cabinet in the dinette and the cabinet in the bathroom. There is also a full basement. The dining space in the kitchen is provided for in addition to the dinette which is part of the living room. 


