Welter Title To Bratton

CHICAGO (CP)—Johnny Bratton last night won the National Boxing Association's version of the welterweight championship by defeating Charley Fusari in a blistering 15-round battle in Chicago Stadium.

Decision was not unanimous. One judge voted 76-74 in favor of Fusari, New Jersey ex-millman. Fusari survived two knockdowns to make a courageous fight from start to finish. Referee Freddie Gilmore joined in voting with the other judge, 78-72, for Bratton.

Bratton dropped Fusari for a count of four in the fourth round with a hard right to the chin. In the tenth, he knocked Fusari sprawling with a savage left hook and a right-cross to the jaw.
