NOXIOUS WEEDS Some noxious weeds have been introduced with imported feeds. Among the more common are quack grass, Canada thistle. bull thistle, sow thistle and mustard.

Canada thistle is possibly somewhat maligned. Horses will eat much of it and goats will eat more, Grasses—at least some varieties-will compete with this successfully.


Bull thistle isn't eaten even by goats. It is either an annar or a biennial, depending on when seed germinates. 
