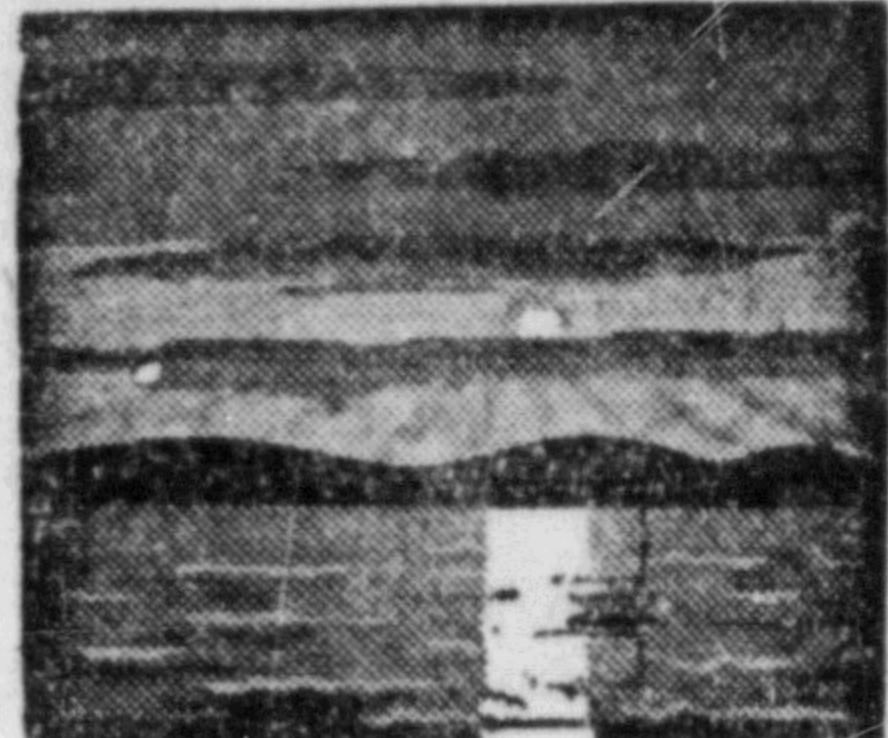

She states that, unless children are "dirty, rough and tough, they aren't accepted." What a statement to make about children anywhere, let alone Prince Rupert!

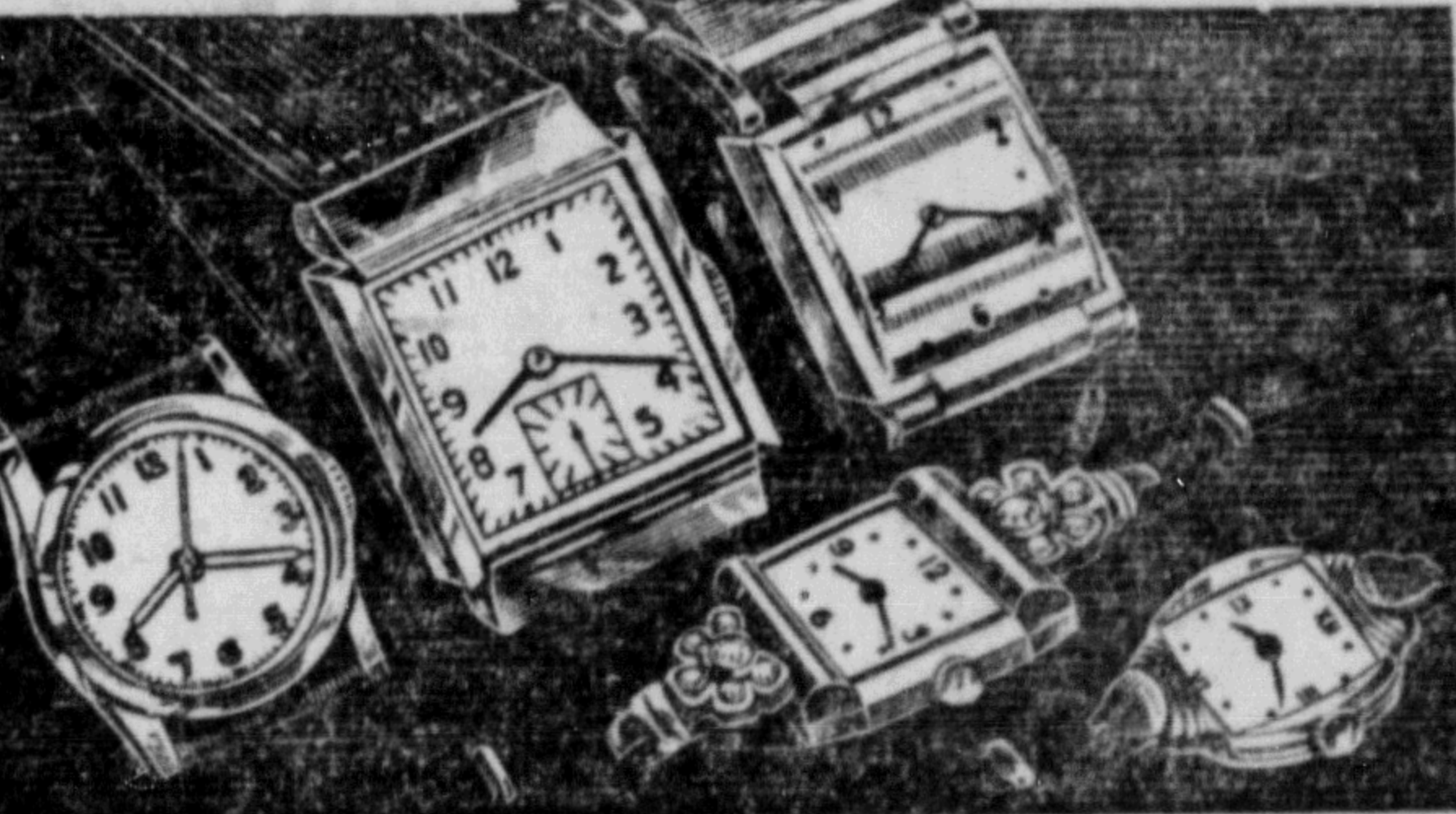

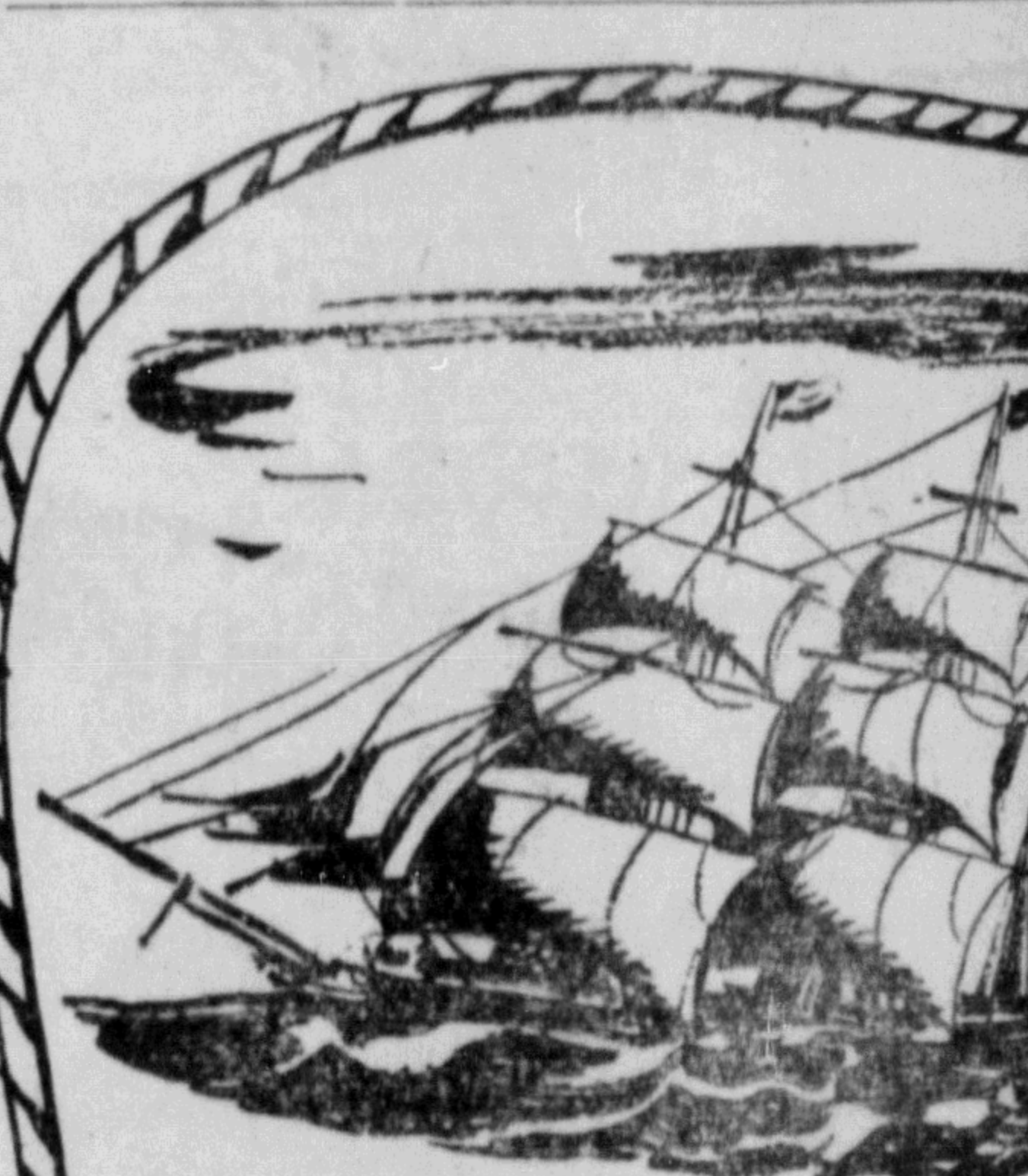
