THE EXPERTS Say...

LEEK COMES INTO OWN
 The leek, an onion-like herb largely ignored by Canadian housewives, has come into its own. Europeans who have brought their culinary skills to Canada are pointing up its value. They have created a demand where hitherto none existed. With this demand has come an increase in price. Where once leeks sold for five cents a bunch, now they cost 15 cents and the demand is growing.

Leek soup, a favorite dish with the French, is one of the tastiest of luncheon treats. Ingredients: Three good-sized leeks; three medium-sized potatoes.

Wash leeks thoroughly, making certain to get all the sand from the leaves. Cut off some of the top but leave on as much of the green as possible. This gives the soup its effective green color. Cut off root end and slice in half-inch pieces.

Peel and cut potatoes in small chunks. Boil with leeks in just enough water to cover the vegetables when they are pressed to bottom of pot.

When cooked, put leeks and potatoes through vegetable strainer. The thick soup resulting should be reheated, then served with plenty of salt and pepper and a chunk of butter. Crusty bread goes well with this dish.

SENTIMENTAL NOTE
 Rose potpourri is for the girl who wants to keep her wedding roses or for any woman who enjoys an old-fashioned rose sachet.

Pluck petals from rose and spread to dry. Sprinkle well with table salt which draws out moisture and helps prevent mold. Turn the leaves each day for about three days.

When dry and crisp, dredge the petals with red roses sachet. Keep them in a box with the lid on for at least 24 hours, until petals have taken up the sachet. Make bags of four layers of rayon, net of tulle, cut in eight-inch squares. Cut another round size of a teacup, at least two-ply, and place on bottom of sachet square to keep powder from sifting through. Draw up the four corners of the square, tie tightly with ribbon, then round or fringe the corners for decoration.

For travelling, make flat pads by folding tulle. For use as hangers in closet, add loops of ribbon for hanging. If all-white petals have been used, add snips of bright red crepe paper to the leaves for color, as seen through the tulle.
