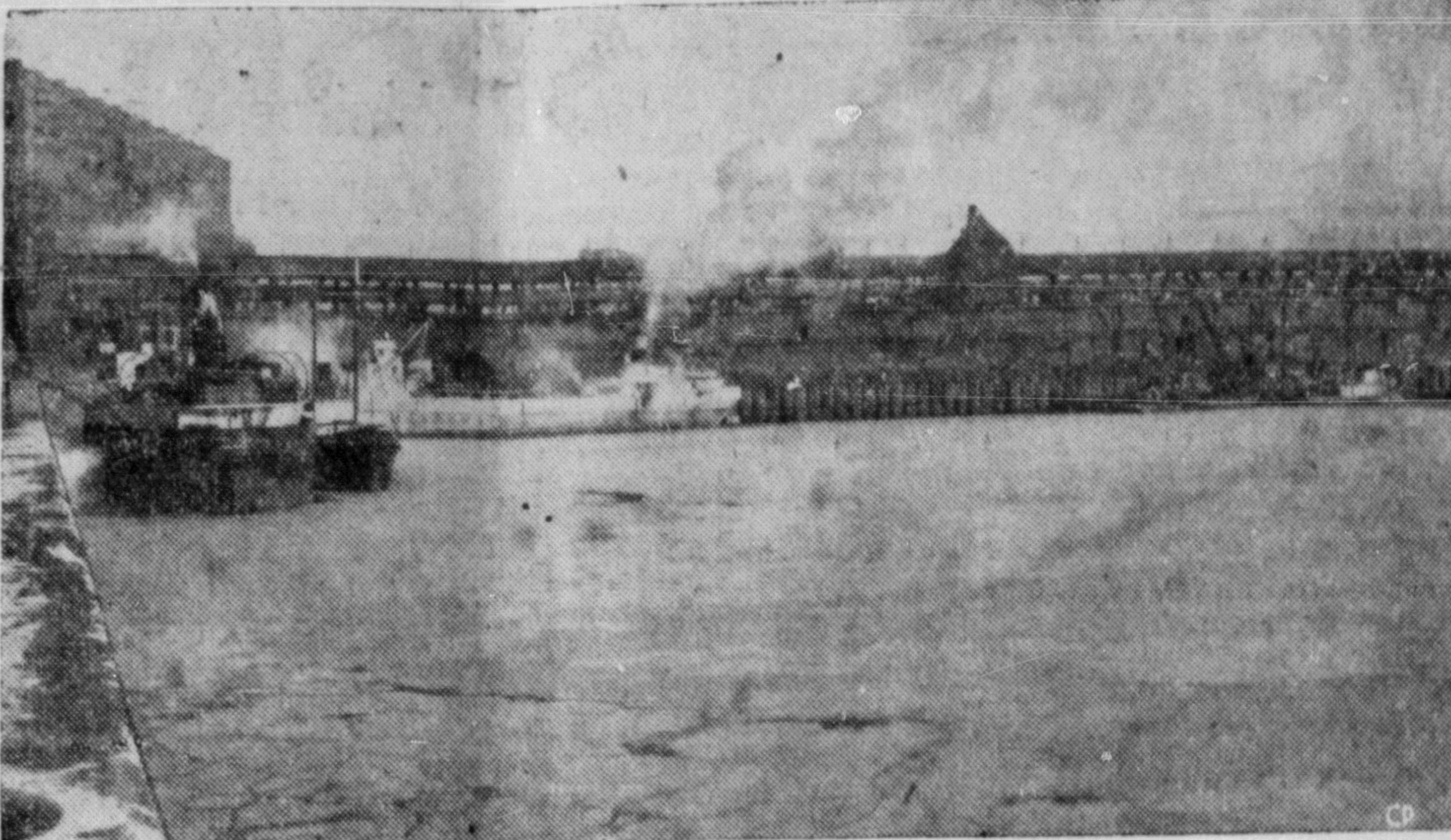
A letter from Commissioner Arneil of British Columbia appealed to the parents to bring their children up as good citizens. Albert Douse acted as chairman for the corporation.

The children, under the direction of the teacher, H. C. Schroeder, presented a program of songs.

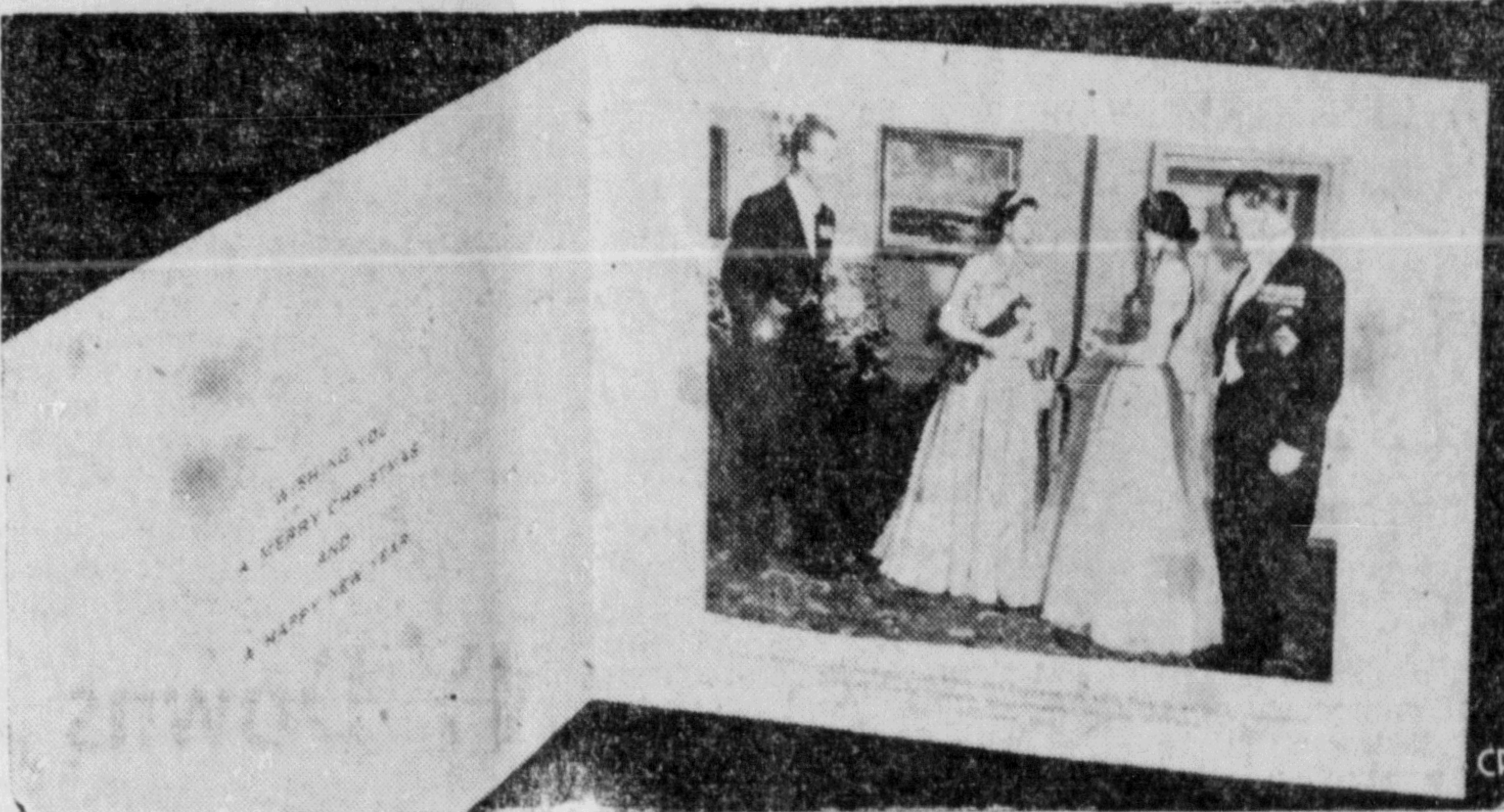
Mr. Hayhurst delivered a brief address, directed principally at the children.

Difficult to Leave Soviet

MONTREAL (CP)—Elinor Lipper, an attractive brunette who spent 11 years in Russian prison camps, in an interview here told reporters some of her experiences behind the Iron Curtain. A native of Switzerland, she said she found that citizens of Soviet Russia have "almost no chance of escaping" their country.

"The west is receiving between 20,000 and 30,000 refugees each month from Soviet satellite states but there's only one in a million chance for any Soviet citizen to come over."

Miss Lipper, visiting Canada and the United States under the auspices of the International Rescue Committee, a group which seeks to help refugees from Iron Curtain countries, was a prisoner for eight years in Siberia and three years in other Russian prisons.

She said she went to Russia as a member of a Communist youth organization. She was arrested shortly afterwards and sent to prison. She was released in 1948 and made her way across the Soviet Union back to Switzerland where she now lives.

Miss Lipper said prisoners in Siberian slave-labor camps never discuss the possibility of escape because no such possibility exists.

"We in the slave camps were no different from Russians who were living freely in various areas. Nobody anywhere talks of leaving."

Miss Lipper, who looks much younger than her 39 years, was once liberated from a camp in the Russian zone of Germany by American troops.

Natives Offer Gifts to Volcano

SYDNEY, Australia (CP)—Natives on Ambryn Island in the New Hebrides group of the south Pacific are "feeding" food and tribal offerings to an active volcano in an effort to stop its eruptions, according to George O'Brien, who has just returned here from the island.

"Natives fashion special shoes out of coconut shells to climb over the lava and hot ashes," he said. "Then they throw into the live crater anything they consider valuable. They are trying this method because they think the white man's prayers have failed."

The volcano, MOUNT MARIUM, threatens the island with desolation and thousands of natives have been evacuated by inter-island steamers.

Some white men also fled the island, but various native groups remain trying to appease the volcano.

Natives fear the smouldering peak may wreck the whole island in a final eruption some day but even if there is no major outbreak the island is considered useless for years to come.
