necessary. One can select two or three varieties of the leaf sort and if planted at intervals of a week from the first day that gardening opens until well on in May or June a steady month's supply is secured. Then it is advisable to include one or two good varieties of the head type. Following this, one can depend on Cos lettuce, which is a heat resistant sort and will stay crisp practically all summer. The latter is a sort of head sort but is much narrower. It is self-blanching an will stay fresh and crisp for several days if sprinkled with water and stored in the refrigerator or cool cellar. All lettuce delights in rich loamy soil, plenty of cultivation, water when necessary, and nitrogen fertilizer.
