Twenty Years Ago

In Prince Rupert

June 14, 1910.
News has been received at the local office of Foley, Welch & Stewart, contractors for the Grand Trunk Pacific, that the company has secured the contract to build twenty-five miles of the Kootenay Central Railway in the upper Columbia River valley from Galloway to Golden.

A delegation consisting of Mayor Fred Stork, Ald. A. R. Barrow, City Engineer A. E. Agnew and the city solicitor will go to Victoria in connection with the application of this city for water rights.

Mayor Fred Stork has declared the afternoon of June 15 a public holiday to celebrate the arrival here from the builders in England of the steamer Prince Rupert, new ship for the service of the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway on this coast.

Having completed her northern calls with dispatch, Union steamer Cardena, Capt. Andrew Johnstone, lay in port here for more than seven hours last evening. The vessel arrived at 4.45 from Wales Island and Port Simpson and sailed at 12 midnight for Vancouver. She had completed her calls in the Skeena River yesterday morning.
