Spite of Low Price Silver Prosperity Mine Paying Well

Stewart subsidiary to Premie Makes Very Good Showing and Will do Better

The production and financial statement of the Prosperity Mine. Premier's latest subsidiary, for June shows production for the month of 1,760 tons, having a gross smelter value of \$54,972, which, after deducting production costs of \$29,-605, and adding adjustments of \$280, leaves a net profit of \$25,-647 for the month.

While these figures for May are not at hand, a comparison with the April report shows that the production in tons was greater in June by 362, but a decrease in average values of the ore from \$38 .-50 to \$32.37 caused a decrease of \$3,465 in the net profit.

The net profit for June is, however, considerably greater than the average monthly profit of \$18.777 for the eight months, during which 10,612 tons of ore were mined, having a gross smelter value of \$32.-37, and from which a net profit of \$14.16 was gained. Except for an almost negligible amount of gold recovered, the production values from this property are almost entirely in silver, and since the company is able to operate at a "Improved in Texture and Taste." profit in spite of the low price of ilver, it is expected the company will be a very satisfactory money- Significance of maker when the hoped-for return Significance of of higher silver prices becomes a
