### HINTS FOR GARDENERS

#### LAWNS

Lime should be used sparingly on the lawn as often as acid soil, which the lime tends to correct, actually discourages the growth of dandelions and plantain, two very objectionable and common weeds. A rich soil is necessary in order to have a good lawn and also good drainage and sunlight. Fertilizers relatively high in nitrogen, which stimulate luxuriant growth, are the best. Liberal amounts of phosphate and potash are also beneficial especially when a lawn is being started for the first time. Five pounds of commercial fertilizer for a hundred square feet is the maximum amount which should be used.

#### POWDERED SILK

Powdered silk from silk and rayon waste is now made in France. It is as fluffy as velvet and used for fine tapestry wall paper and other fancy decorative effects.
