# CORPORATION Income Tax Return DUE APRIL 30th

Every corporation or joint stock company is required to make an Income Tax Return on or before April 30th;

-and to include with this return, cheque or cash for at least 25% of the tax payable.

Failure to make such return renders the delinquent liable to a penalty equal to 5% (five percent) of the tax payable (maximum \$500).

### Use Form T2

Corporation Income Tax Returns should be made on form T2, which form may be obtained from any Income Tax Inspector or Postmaster.

The Department of National Revenue bespeaks the co-operation of all corporations in an effort to complete the work involved promptly, effectively and economically—to all concerned.


School Teacher Writes to "Prince Rupert, Alaska" For a Job


