The storage-dam will be located at about 8 chains above Govt. fish ladder in Lot No. 2450.
The capacity of the reservoir to be created is about 370,000 acres of land. The water will be diverted from the stream at a point near the storage dam and will be used for power purpose upon the lands described as Portland Canal Mining Division.
