SOUNDINGS TAKEN IN READINESS FOR WORK

Although definite plans for the new addition to be made west of the present Grand Trunk wharf, are not yet completed a fairly definite idea as to the extent of these improvements may be given. An addition of 1,100 feet is to be put on which will nearly double the present wharfage, it being now 1,500 feet long. Large sheds will be erected on the new wharf.

When the new dock is completed it will provide more accommodation for the heavy shipments of salmon that are passing through here at the present time and are taxing the available accommodation to the utmost. It will also allow more room for other kinds of freight if necesfsary. The new slips being built for the Whalen pulp will eliminate any handling of that comcodity at the docks and with the new wharfage, the freight and storage situation shuold not be so congested another season.

Active operations have not yet begun on the wharf proper, but sounding has been going on for some time, in order to ascertain the exact depths for the driving of piles. It is much more economical and convenient to know the depths beforehand so that the piles can be cut about the right length before the driving begins.
