TEACHERS MUST STAY

Board Expects They Will Remain Until Final Day of School Term

A suggestion from teachers of the King Edward High School, submitted through the principal, D. H. Hartness, and with his approval, had members of the teaching staff be allowed to leave on conclusion of examinations, a few days before the statutory date for school closing at the end of this month, did not find favor with the board of school trustees on being brought up at last night's meeting. The teachers will be informed that the board has no authority to allow them the time off and that they will be expected to remain at their posts until the end of the term.

It was explained that grade examinations would be over on June 9, and the matriculation exams a few days later. Principal Hartness saw no reason why the teachers should be required to stay around after the examinations.

In a discussion on the question which followed, the opinion was expressed by members of the board that, as the term did not conclude until June 27, it was but reasonable that the teachers should remain at work. In any other work, it would be required. It was suggested that here might be matters preparatory to next year's work that might well be taken up during the last few lack days. There was also presiding examiner work.

The consensus of opinion was unfavorable to the suggestion that the teachers leave before June 27.
