CAPITAL AND LABOR DISCUSSED BY COL. McMORDIE

of what they honestly believed to be theirs, and they could see little hope of bettering their condition. As a result many of them believed the golden promises of the alien and home born agitators and permitted themselves to be enticed into paths which lead to revolution and anarchy.

Labor's Demands.

The speaker went on to say that the demands of labor were many and varied. Generally speaking they asked that the wages should be sufficient for him to maintain his family in comfort, that his hours of labor should always leave him sufficient time for reasonable amusement, recreation and the betterment of his mind, in addition to the necessary hours of rest. The legal day in this country is now one of eight hours and it is generally accepted as being fair, but the possibility of its being shortened at some future time should always be kept in mind. At present that did not appear possible, as there is a shortage of production.

Other suggestions for the betterment of labor were made by Col. McMordie in:

- Old age pensions.
- Out of work insurance.
- Maternity bonuses.
- Strike prevention.

In regard to the last mentioned of these it was well known that while everyone suffered in case of a strike, the one that suffered most was the poor and the weak. The feeling was becoming general that strikes were not the best means of settling disputes between capital and labor. Disputes should be submitted to tribunals of trained experts and their decision should be final and binding on both parties to the contract.

Get Together.

In the past, said the speaker, labor had been the under dog. He looked for a time within the next thirty years when more nearly ideal conditions would obtain. The personal element could not be eliminated from dealings between capital and labor. Employer and employee must learn to know each other better. He advised that labor turn to the ballot box as the best means of fighting any wrongs as being the legitimate method rather than by trying to gain political ends through the general strike, as in the latter case the cause of labor would surely suffer.
