Chief Engineer Knobel of Mackenzie & Mann interests passed through the city enroute to Stewart where he will lay out railway construction work for the coming season.

The Stewart, Portland Canal, Light, Water and Power Co. Ltd. has been incorporated with capitalization of \$25,000 and will supply the town of Stewart and adjoining mines with water, light and power.

L. F. Smith of the Prince Rupert Fisheries Experimental Station staff returned to the city on yesterday afternoon's train from Terrace, having hiked part of the way there on Sunday.

WATER NOTICE

Use and Storage.

Take notice that Northern British Columbia Power Company Limited whose address is Besner Block, Prince Rupert, B.C., will apply for a license to take and use 1,000 C.F.S. and to store 370,000 acre feet of water out of Meziadin Lake and Meziadin River, which flows south-westerly and drains into the Neas River about 115 miles above tidewater and 69 miles from Alyanah, B.C.

The storage-dams will be located at about 8 chains above Govt. fish ladder in Lot No. 2450. The capacity of the reservoir to be created is about 370,000 acre feet, and it will flood about 6,000 acres of land. The water will be diverted from the stream at a point near the storage-dam and will be used for power purposes upon the lands described as Portland Canal Mining Division.

This notice is posted on the ground on the 15th day of March, 1930. A copy of this notice and an application pursuant thereto and to the "Water Act" will be filed in the office of the Water Recorder at Prince Rupert, B.C.

Objections to the application may be filed with the said Water Recorder or with the Comptroller of Water Rights, Parliament Buildings, Victoria, B.C., within thirty days after the first appearance of this notice in a local newspaper. Within a radius of 125 miles of the power site.
