

Bird Baths

One of the most interesting and useful ornaments which can be used upon your grounds is a bird bath. Too much cannot be said in its favor. It can be as beautiful as a small fountain and the birds which it attracts make it a desirable fea-

The bird bath should be well designed so that it will add to the beauty of our grounds as well as have an attraction for the birds. A well-designed bird bath should have a rough surface for a foothold, and should slope gradually to the centre, so that the birds can enjoy the water at any depth they choose and so that they will have ample room in which to sun themselves. When the bird bath does not have a gentle slope a few stones placed in the bolw will often serve the same pur-
