BANFF PARK SET ASIDE IN 1885

Banff national park in the province of Alberta is the oldest of the Dominion playgrounds, the original reservation having been set aside in 1885. It comprises an area of 3,830.5 square miles of territory. Reserved for the enjoyment of all who visit it, it is also a wild life sanctuary, evidence of which is manifest in the large number of sheep, deer and bear to be seen in the areas adjacent to the highways of the park.

GRAVITY COMPARISONS Measurements of the force of gravity at various points throughout the country are made by the Dominion Observatory, Ottawa. This involves the measurement of the period of a pendulum to one ten millionth part of a second—a decidedly delicate operation. Results of these investigations are intended to throw light on the nature of the upper layers of the earth's crust, and are closely related to geological formations and such processes as denudation and mountain-building.
