

HINTS FOR GARDENERS

"I would have a garden too if I owned my own place," is a very common remark at this time of the year, but like many other opinions it will not hold water when it comes to the testing point.

Instead of shrubbery at the back of the garden or screening the house foundation, fences or garage, tall, quickly growing annuals, cosmos, marigolds, dahlias, zinnias, sunflowers, castor oil beans, four o'clocks and similar plants will be used.

Along the front use small edging material like alyssum, lobelia, ageratum, dwarf nasturtiums and dwarf marigolds. With a little extra quick-ly available fertilizer, such as nitrate of soda, a little attention to cultivation and watering and a little forethought in selecting varieties, one can have a bloom all summer and a garden from July on that will make a very fair rival of the more expensive permanent affair that has been in process of development for five years.

NOTICE is hereby given that by Proclamation of the Lieutenant-Governor made the 7th day of May, 1930, Part V. of the "Highway Act" came into force on the 15th day of May, 1930, and after the said last-mentioned date no person shall carry on upon a highway in any unorganized district or on any arterial or primary highway within a Municipality, by means of a public vehicle, the business of a public carrier of freight, or of passengers, or of passengers and freight, unless he is the holder of a public carrier's licence therefor or is exempted under the terms of Part V. of the "Highway Act" or regulations made thereunder.

WATER NOTICE

Use and Storage. Take notice that Northern British Columbia Power Company Limited whose address is Besner Block, Prince Rupert, B.C., will apply for a license to take and use 1,900 C.F.S. and to store 370,000 acre feet of water out of Meziadin Lake and Meziadin River, which flows south-easterly and drains into the Naas River about 115 miles above tidewater and 69 miles from Alyssan, B.C.

The storage-dam will be located at about 8 chains above Govt. fish ladder in Lot No. 2450. The capacity of the reservoir to be created is about 370,000 acre feet, and it will flood about 6,000 acres of land. The water will be diverted from the stream at a point near the storage dam and will be used for power purposes upon the lands described as Portland Canal Mining Division.

This notice was posted on the ground on the 31st day of March, 1930. A copy of this notice and an application pursuant thereto and to the "Water Act" will be filed in the office of the Water Recorder at Prince Rupert, B.C.

Objections to the application may be filed with the said Water Recorder or with the Comptroller of Water Rights, Parliament Buildings, Victoria, B.C., within thirty days after the first appearance of this notice in a local newspaper.

The petition for approval of undertaking and an application for approval of the Schedule of Tolls will be heard in the office of the Board of Investigation at a date to be fixed, and any interested person may file an objection thereto in the office of the Comptroller or of the Water Recorder of the District.
