C.P.R. steamer Princess Charlotte, Capt. C. C. Saintey, making her initial voyage north of the season on the Alaska route, arrived in port at 10 o'clock this morning from Vancouver with a large list of tourist passengers and sailed at 12 noon for Skagway.

Col. Thomas A. Hiam, assistant to the president of the Canadian National Railways with headquarters in Vancouver, arrived in the city on the Prince George this morning in the course of an official tour north. Col. Hiam will proceed from here to the interior.

Rev. Dr. F. W. Dafeo, pastor of First Baptist Church, will sail on the Prince George tomorrow evening for a trip to Vancouver.

At the joint meeting of the Rotary and Gyro Clubs yesterday, B. J. Mellish told the members about the Vancouver Sunday newspapers being sent next Sunday by airplane and urged all to buy a copy for the benefit of the Boys' Band.

Capt. John Irving of Victoria, veteran navigator of this coast, was a passenger aboard the Princess Charlotte this morning bound for Juneau where he will embark on an American steamer for Valdez in which district he has mining business.
