Petition Received By City Council From Property Owners on South Side of Second

Property owners, in a petition presented to the city council last night, asked for the building under local improvement of a new board walk with cedar underpinning and fir decking on the south side of Second Avenue from First to Third Streets.

J. A. Curtis, who was present, told the council that owners of 19 of the 36 lots concerned had signed the petition and that another owner now wished to sign. Four more of the lots were owned by the government and four by the city. Mr. Curtis spoke skeptically of the proposed asphaltic sidewalk plan advocated by the city engineer. He. for one at least, did not wish to have to pay for an experiment.
