PROTEST POLICE PRESENCE

Editor, Daily News:—
As secretary of the Unemployed Association of this city, I have been asked to bring to the attention of the public, what appears to the workers at the relief camp at Cloyah Bay to be rather an unfortunate demonstration of law and order.

I refer specifically to the attachment at the camp of a provincial police officer, and the Central Committee of the Unemployed Association desire to inform the public at large, that such an action is not conducive to the harmony expected between the authorities and the workers. I might add that as an association we have approached all difficulties in a sane and gentlemanly manner, and in fairness to the local authorities we must admit that we have been received at all times most graciously.

Furthermore the association is in no way identified with any other organization, legal or otherwise, and to flout the strong arm of the law in the face of law abiding unfortunates is parallel almost to waving a red rag at the proverbial bull, a most unwise action by authority or citizens.

No complaint is offered against the officer in person at time of writing, but his presence as an officer almost indicates apprehension of a non-existent trouble. If reactionary efforts were contemplated, one personification of His Majesty will not dissipate the same. Somehow or other we feel that the dog might just as well be hung as given a bad name.
