To add to this already heavy burden of the fisherman, I might add that the old established buyer, who we are all glad to welcome once more, is milking the fisherman drier than ever, by charging three cents more for gasoline than it can be bought for, by the consumer in Prince Rupert. The cost of conveyance of gasoline to the fishing grounds has in past years, never been more than two cents per gallon, and has more frequently been one and one-half, and one cent.

It is thus evident that the proverbial fly still contaminates the ointment and that the potential prosperity may be only a veneer, and not the genuine article.
