There are a total of 69 pupils now in attendance at the Stewart Superior School.

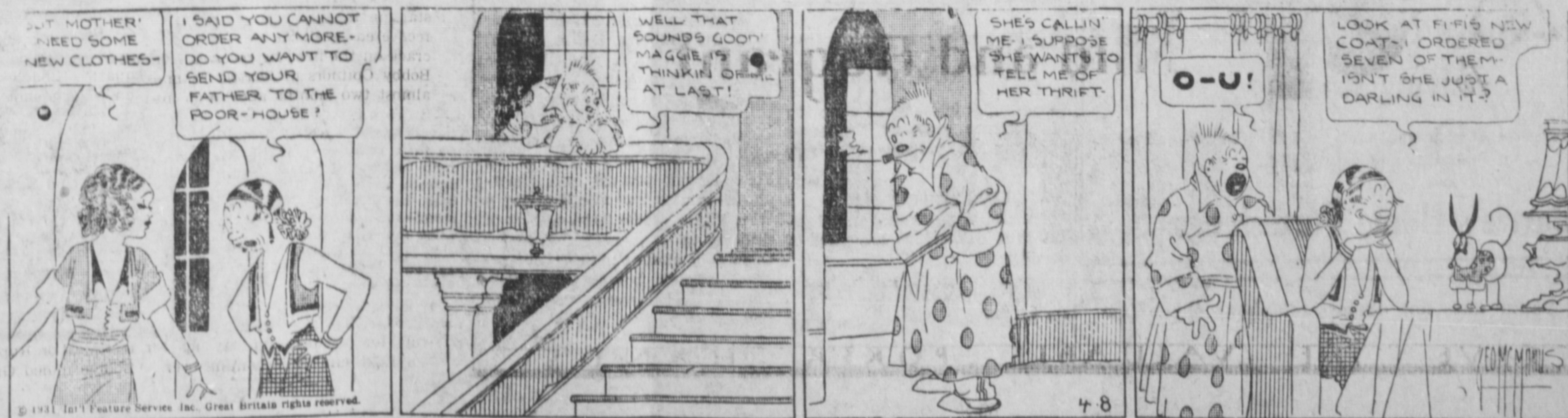
