New Industries are being planned for the district, announcement of which will be made in the near future. A new Hydro-Electric Power Plant has been installed and is now in operation.

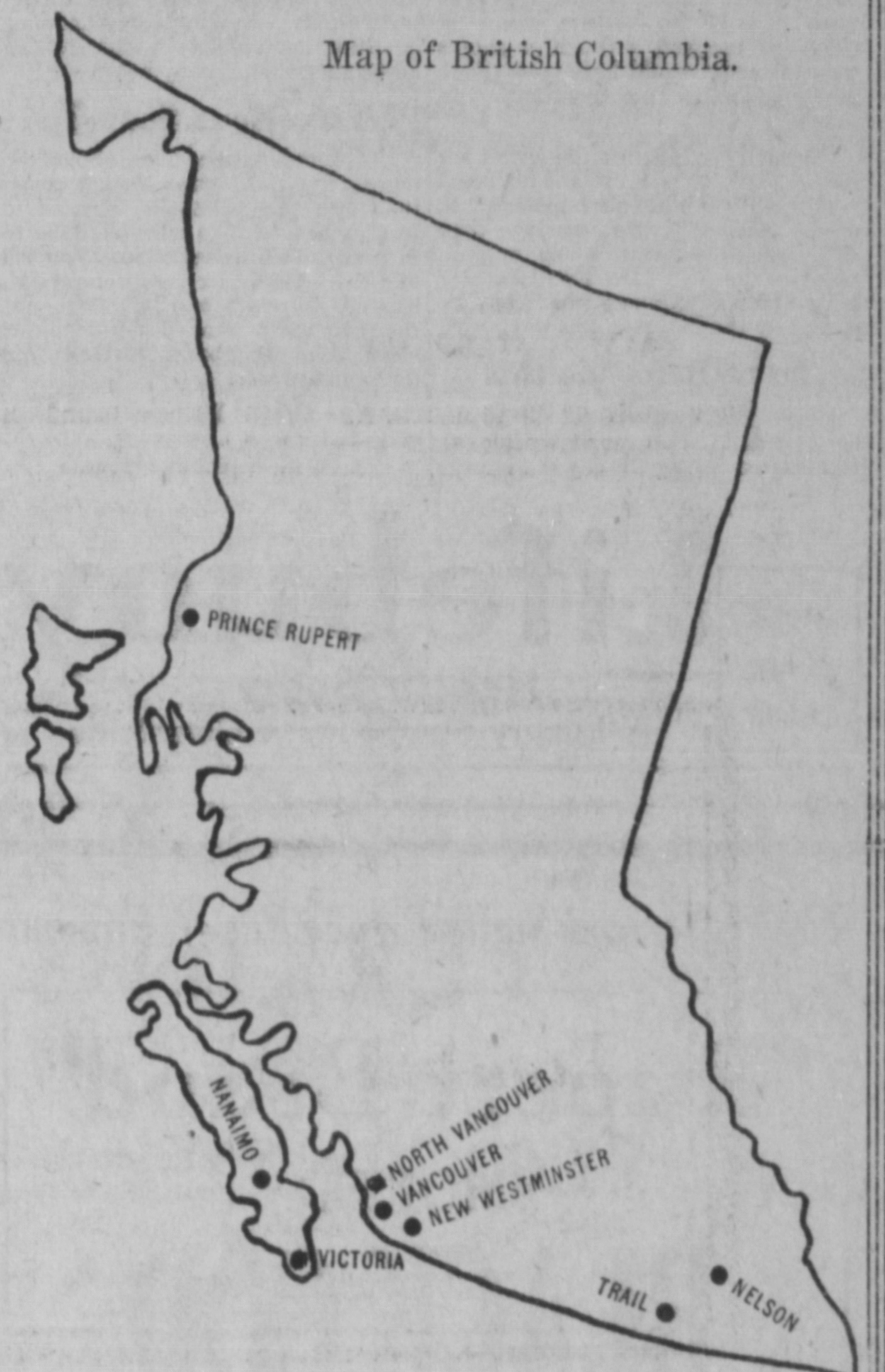
