Two or Three Years Yet Before Dome Is Fully Restored

ROME, Sept. 25.—Restoration of the buttresses of the drum supporting the dome of St. Peter's is showing appreciable progress since the work was begun about three years ago, but it is probable it will be two or three years yet before the restoration will be completed.

Several of the massive party walls of travertine constructed between the buttress and pillars of the drum were found to be cracked and have now been repaired with new blocks of travertine. Similarly, new blocks of travertine have been fitted into the core of the drum itself, and in some sections of it where the old blocks have been left a special cement has been forced into the cracks.

When the work was being begun the Pope insisted on accompanying the responsible architect, Senator Beltrami, on the scaffolding in order to see for himself the need of the undertaking, and he has continued to follow the operations with the closest attention.

ED. LIPSETT TELLS ABOUT HIS JOURNEY

Impressed With Prince Rupert After Having Visited Most Big Cities of Europe

After travelling through most of the large cities of Europe with Mrs. Lipsett, and attending the Rotary International convention in Vienna, Ed. Lipsett of Vancouver, proprietor of the business which bears his name here, told the local Rotary Club yesterday that he never had seen Prince Rupert looking as well as it did today. Only when he looked at his books did he realize that there was anything wrong. He said he felt there was a community spirit creeping up in the city. He had once told the merchants here that the city would go ahead in spite of the people and he still thought it was going to be a good place. There were more signs of prosperity here today than in most places in Canada and the city would come out all right.

Mr. Lipsett told very humorously of incidents in his trip. He mentioned the courtesy of railway officials and said he found that they were coming to realize that passengers were really a factor in their business. He travelled through Germany, Austria, Czechoslovakia and a number of other countries and he found the countries looking prosperous, the people well dressed and showing none of the signs of distress which one would gather from newspaper reports that they were suffering.

The traveller visited Cherbourg, Antwerp, Brussels, Budapest, Prague, Dresden, Berlin, Copenhagen, Stockholm, Bergen, Glasgow, Dublin, Belfast, London, and many other places. He sailed down the Danube and found it anything but blue. It was muddier than either the Fraser or the Skeena. He had sailed on the Clyde and it was distressing to see the deserted shipyards. Only two vessels were noticed there where once the sound of the rivetter's hammer was heard day and night.

Mr. Lipsett gave a racy sketch of the work of the big world convention at Vienna where he represented and voted for six clubs, five in Canada, including Prince Rupert, and one in the States. He described the huge concert house, the House of Friendship, the receptions and garden parties and told something of the speakers. It was a wonderful event.
