#### CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT

TAKE NOTICE THAT:

1. The Council of the Corporation of the City of Prince Rupert intends to construct a sanitary sewer in the lane south of 9th Avenue from the lane between Block 40 and 41, Section 5, to Lot 12, Block 41, Section 5, in 9th Avenue from Lot 18, Block 33, Section 5, to Lot 27, Block 33, Section 5, in lane south of 8th Avenue from Lobbiners Street to Tallow Street; in 8th Avenue from Tallow Street to Fulton Street; in 7th Avenue from Tallow Street to Taylor Street; in Fulton Street from 8th Avenue to Lot 32, Block 27, Section 5, thence westerly through Lot 32, Block 27, Section 5, to Taylor Street; and in Taylor Street from Lot 32, Block 27, Section 5, to 6th Avenue with lateral thereto, as a local improvement, and intends to specially assess the cost upon the land abutting directly on the work, except such portion of the cost as is incurred at street intersections.

2. The estimated cost of the work is \$15,600.00 of which \$3,029.95 is to be paid by the Corporation, and the estimated annual special rate per frontage is \$0.2805. The special assessment is to be paid in 20 annual instalments.

3. Persons desiring to petition against undertaking the work must do so on or before the 11th day of July, 1931.
