In the Letter Box

PLAIN SPEECH FROM ONTARIO

To the Editor:—

As one of the tax-payers of Third Avenue, I have read with astonishment of a recent proposal before the council to adorn that thoroughfare with a new and expensive form of illumination. Why? The street is quite well lighted for practical purposes, and much too well lighted for the beauty of its architecture or the importance of its public buildings.

Does the author of the proposal wish to throw the grandeur of the post office into higher relief, or is it the debris that clusters about the short cut to the Anglican Church that he would bring into greater publicity.

One Satisfaction.

To us property owners at a distance who have to shoulder such a considerable part of the city's burdens, it is satisfactory to learn that there is money in the treasury for any sort of improvement. Certainly there is no lack of inviting directions in which to spend it. But let us begin with the basic things and the most basic of all is sanitation.

You cannot build a successful city on defective sewers. A house built upon the sands has a pleasant and dignified fate in comparison. I am not afraid to say, and I hope you will not be offended to hear, that if it were not for Prince Rupert's incomparably healthy climate and cleansing rain, the odors of the town would groan for burial like Mark Anthony's carriage men. Last summer I remember one particular shop frontage behind which business must have been carried on at a disadvantage, as nobody could possibly linger there, however attractive the display.

Next to Godliness.

Cleanliness is next to godliness and a long way ahead of illumination. The proposal to buy cluster lamps for Third Avenue and go on with the present system of patching up the sewers reminds one of the bohunk that adorns his shirt front with an expensive sparkler for the party but neglects to wash behind his ears. Wash behind your ears.
